Life Education is involved in educating children about the effects and risks associated with the use of all drugs, including alcohol and tobacco, and promoting the benefits of a balanced diet and exercise.

In Bromley during 2013 we visited 60 schools and had 17,000 children through our mobile classroom.

We are Managed by a small group of volunteer Trustees together with a number of paid 'Teachers'. The Trustees include Rotarians from Crofton & Orpington and Bromley (Michael Hitchens).

Our History - we have been operating in Bromley for over 25 years. Bromley Rotary support Life Education with donations and importantly, by providing a representative Trustee. Originally this Trustee was Dennis Knight but for the past 15 years it has been Michael Hitchens.

Funding - we get no funding from the local authority - we depend entirely on donations. It costs about £100,000 per year to run the Bromley operation. We have to charge the schools a small amount for providing this service.

Support - apart from financial support, we have to rely on the time of our volunteer Trustees to help with management & administration, recruitment of staff, and importantly, the day-to-day maintenance of the mobile classroom.
