**TREE OF LIGHT—CHRISTMAS 2014**

The Bromley Rotary Club tree will once again be illuminated in the grounds of Bromley Parish Church and you are invited to dedicate a light in memory of a relative, friend or for a good cause which you wish to be remembered. With this year marking the centenary of the start of the First World War, in addition to the sponsored ‘tree’ we are also providing poppies by way of remembrance for those who lost their lives during the war and other conflicts for which donations will be made to The Royal British Legion.

You can sponsor a light or as many lights that you wish for a minimum donation of £5 per light. In acknowledgement, a named tree or poppy will be placed on a Floodlit Memorial Board in the church grounds near the tree of lights and will remain in place throughout the Christmas period.

The Tree will be switched on at 4.30 p.m. on Saturday 22nd November, accompanied by the Salvation Army Band providing a selection of seasonal songs and carols. Free refreshments will be served in the church hall courtesy of Co-Operative Funeral Care.

*A replica of the Tree of light card (or poppy) will be sent to you on receipt of a self-addressed envelope (8” x 6”) with your donation.*
